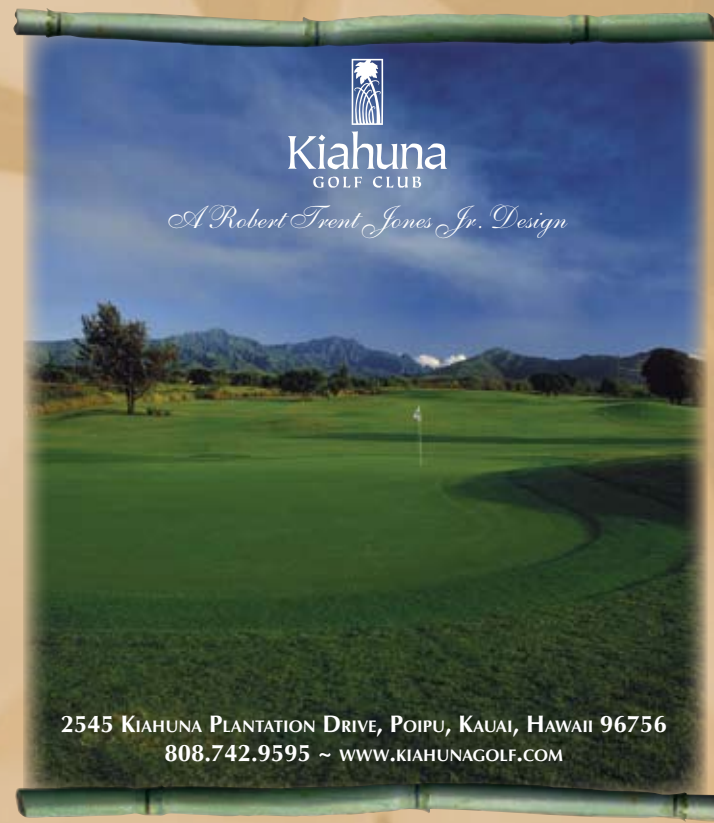

- Players are responsible for any damages caused by errant shots.

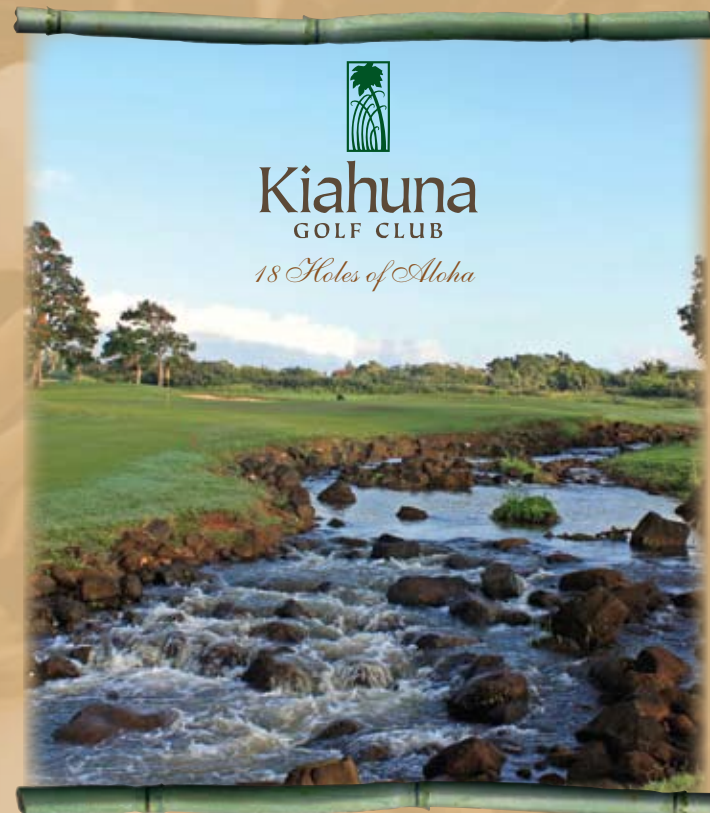
*The 15th fairway is what is left of the house of a Portuguese immigrant who lived during the early 19th century. Apparently, the man was in charge of controlling the irrigation of the surrounding farmland by diverting the Waikomo stream that runs through the 12th hole, a tricky par three.
